

# St. Vital resident begins prestigious Lions Clubs role

Considering some people's passion for the irresistible appeal of chocolate, it says something that Jan Nazarko has had a pin made that reads, "Being a Lion is better than chocolate."

Making chocolate is a hobby for Nazarko, an old St. Vital resident, who formally started in her role as Lions Clubs

International's district governor for 5M11 on July 1. Significantly, Nazarko is the first female in Canada to hold the role.

"(The pin) is what I give to different people I know and special guests at events. Gordon, my son, designed it," Nazarko said.

In her new role, Nazarko will oversee the district's 65 clubs, which are located in parts of Manitoba and Minnesota.

Her responsibilities will be wide-ranging, including monitoring daily operations, navigating topical issues such as helping the Lac du Bonnet club secure a grant to help recent wildfire victims, assisting schools and organizations that want to build accessible playgrounds, and aiding low-income families.

"I'm excited, nervous, and looking forward to it," Nazarko said recently, noting the district governor role will also include lots of travel, as it's an international position.

"I have help, and we work as a team. There are lots of people helping out."

According to www.lionsclubs.org, "Lions have served with uncommon kindness, putting the needs of our neighbours, our communities and our world first. Through the incredible work of our Lion and Leo members, and the support of the association and our global foundation, we are serving a world in need together."

Noting Lions Clubs International is one of the largest service organizations in the world, Nazarko said when disaster strikes somewhere in the world, the club's members "are usually one of the first organizations on the ground."




